Question 1: Effectiveness of the Curriculum - Equipping Graduates with a Strong Foundation


Excellent: 8%

# Question 2: Practical Skills Application and Theoretical Concepts


Excellent: 1%

# Question 3: Multidisciplinary Approach and Adaptation


Excellent: 6%

## **Question 4: Continuous Learning and Adaptability**


Excellent: 5%

# Question 5: Integration of Practical Experiences for Professional Readiness


Excellent: 3%
