Question 1: Effectiveness of Equipping Graduates with a Strong Foundation



Question 2: Showcasing Practical Skills and Application of Theoretical Concepts


Excellent: 3%

Question 3: Multidisciplinary Approach and Adaptation


Excellent: 2%

Question 4: Promoting Continuous Learning and Adaptability


Excellent: 4%

Question 5: Integration of Practical Experiences for Readiness


Excellent: 2%
