METHODOLOGY

The questions focused on curriculum's ability to equip graduates with strong foundations, practical skills, adaptability, multidisciplinary approach, and integration of practical experiences.

SUMMARY OF RESPONSES

Effectiveness of Curriculum in Equipping Graduates (Q1):


Excellent: 2%

Very Good: 14%

Good: 72%

Average: 12%

Poor: 0%



Analysis: The majority of employers view the curriculum as effective in equipping graduates with a strong foundation, as 72% rated it as "Good." Only a minor percentage (14%) rated it as "Very Good," suggesting some room for improvement in catering to advanced challenges.

Practical Skills Application in Real-World Scenarios (Q2):


Excellent: 0%

Fostering Multidisciplinary Approach (Q3):


Excellent: 1%

Promotion of Continuous Learning and Adaptability (Q4):


Excellent: 0%

Integration of Practical Experiences (Q5):


