Question 1: Curriculum covers a wide range of relevant topics in the field of study



Question 2: There is sufficient balance between theoretical knowledge and practical application in the curriculum



Question 3: The curriculum encourage critical thinking, problem solving and analytic skills.



Question 4: The curriculum incorporate emerging trends and development in the industry



Question 5: The add-on courses are effective to go deep into specific areas of course



Question 6: The classrooms and lecture halls are comfortable and well equipped for effective learning



Question 7: Library resources, digital databases, and research materials are accessible and available



Question 8: The campus environment promotes overall student well-being and a sense of community



Question 9: The campus is well maintained and clean



Question 10: The institutions effort in organizing co-curricular and extracurricular activities enhance the overall learning experience


