Question 1: Satisfied with the overall structure and design of the curriculum



Question 2: The curriculum encourage critical thinking and problem solving skills among students



Question 3: The curriculum effectively incorporates real world applications and practical experiences to enhance student learning



Question 4: The curriculum integrates technology and digital resources to enhance the teaching and learning experience



Question 5: Satisfied with the support and professional development opportunities provided by the college




Question 6: The physical facilities and infrastructure of the college is comfortable and conductive Strongly Disagree: 0%

Question 7: The college provides a collaborative and supportive environment among faculty members and staff



Question 8: The college encourages and facilitate your participation in professional development, research and scholarly activities



Question 9: College maintains a clean, safe, and well-equipped campus environment



Question 10: Overall ambience and atmosphere for teaching is excellent


